Impact and sustainability this spend has on Key Indicator 1: New astroturf pitch installed on the field. A new astroturf pitch has been laid on what was a grass area, this will increase our usage of the area as the grass was often too wet and muddy to use.

Impact and sustainability this spend has on Key Indicator 2: Opportunity for learners in Upper KS2 to have swimming lessons. Giving all of our learners the opportunity to have 1 swimming lesson per week for 3 terms, giving them lessons on how to be safe in the water and giving them the opportunity to learn to swim.

Impact and sustainability this spend has on Key Indicator 3: Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport. We hope that teachers will grow in confidence because they will have an up to date and appropriate new area for them to manage pupils learning PE and Sport and also having extra space for recreational sport.

Impact and sustainability this spend has on Key Indicator 4: Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils. Having all this new usable space will have an impact on delivering a broad range of activities, not least because land and space that was previously often unusable will now be available 365 days a year. Buying and loaning equipment of sports that are less accessible such as archery, curling and boccia. On top of this buying bikes for our KS1 learners to use during their playtimes.

Impact and sustainability this spend has on Key Indicator 5: Dance to be taught to our KS1 & KS2 learners by an external professional dance teacher.

Giving our learners the opportunity to experience dance lessons from a professional dance teacher throughout a whole term.

Impact and sustainability this spend has on Key Indicator 6: Wet pour installed in our **KS1 playground.** Giving our youngest learners a better area for them to use during their learning time and playtime to increase their opportunity to be outside and to make the area safer for them whilst learning and playing.
