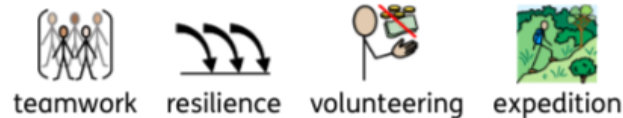


Valued – Inspired – Prepared
