

SMSC and British Values at Westhaven overview

What is SMSC?

It is the Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural development of the learners in our school. This is not a separate subject that is taught explicitly but an aspect of learning that should be present in lessons and behaviour in school. Some lessons lend themselves more easily to direct SMSC development such as PSHE and RE. We also aim to develop SMSC through worship, behaviour expectations and our attitudes in school as well as our weekly SMSC assemblies.

British Values

As articulated in the Government's 'Prevent' strategy we have a focus on the core British values which are: Democracy, The Rule of Law, Individual Liberty, Mutual Respect and Tolerance of those of different faiths and beliefs.

Through our SMSC provision we:

- Enable learners to develop their self-knowledge, self-esteem and self-confidence.
- Enable learners to distinguish right from wrong and to respect the civil and criminal law of England.
- Encourage learners to accept responsibility for their behaviour, show initiative, and to understand how they can contribute positively to the lives of those living and working in the locality of the school and to society more widely.
- Enable learners to acquire a broad general knowledge of and respect for public institutions and services in England.
- Further tolerance and harmony between different cultural traditions by enabling students to acquire an appreciation of and respect their own and other cultures.
- Encourage respect for other people.
- Encourage respect for democracy and support for participation in the democratic processes, including respect on the basis on which the law is made and applied in England.

This underpins our ethos to developing SMSC in school. We ensure opportunities for developing the British Values through our SMSC.

How do we ensure there are opportunities for SMSC development?

At Westhaven School we recognise that the personal development of learners' spiritually, morally, socially and culturally plays a significant part in their ability to learn and achieve. We want to give each learner the opportunity to explore social and moral issues; develop a sense of social and moral responsibility and promote British Values. We therefore aim to provide an education that provides children with opportunities to explore and develop:

- Their own values and beliefs
- Their own spiritual awareness
- Their own high standards of personal behaviour
- Their team and collaborative skills
- A positive, caring attitude towards other people
- An understanding of their social and cultural traditions
- An understanding of democratic processes and the law in England
- An appreciation and acceptance of the diversity and richness of their cultures
- Their opportunities to experience other cultures
- Their ability to celebrate each other's successes
- Their access to a range of educational visits

Our opportunities for SMSC development are continuously growing and evolving.

Links with the Wider Community

- Visitors are welcomed into our school
- Links with the local churches are fostered
- Visits to places of worship of other faiths will be arranged to support the understanding of different cultures
- The school supports the work of a variety of charities
- The development of a strong home-school agreement is regarded as very important, enabling parents and teachers to work in an effective partnership to support the children
- Children will be taught to appreciate and take responsibility for their local environment
- Liaison with local schools to support the curriculum and effective transition, takes place regularly

Our links with the wider community continue to evolve through our citizenship curriculum.

- inquisitive thinkers










The Westhaven Way is our ethos and it underpins our daily approach to behaviour and learning.

At Westhaven, English is the heart of our curriculum. We are committed to raising the standards in phonics and early reading of our learners through every curriculum subject.





















At Westhaven, we follow the approach to phonics teaching as outlined in the DfE validated programme UNLOCKING LETTERS AND SOUNDS.
