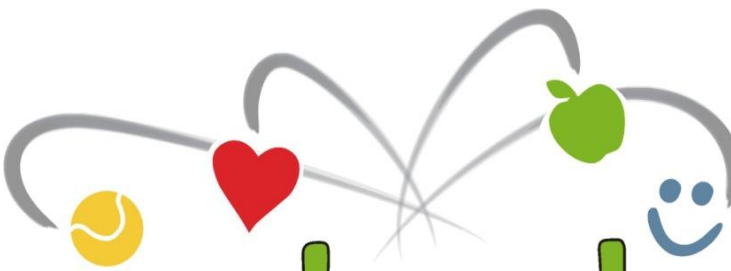

Outcome 1: Increase learner awareness in safety and independence

PSHE training alongside trip leader training have given staff more confidence in teaching PSHE and organising visits. More visits are now being organised and SEMH learners in particular have benefited from the trips organised. These visits as well as in school activities have enabled pupils to be more aware of general safety issues and be more independent.

Outcome 2: Improve mental wellbeing through enrichment activities

A wider range of clubs have been offered over the year and there has been a big increase in the number of pupils attending these; 99% this year compared to 22% last year. This is great progress and will support pupils' general confidence and wellbeing. Hopefully this will be reflected in parent and pupil survey outcomes.

Outcome 3: Increase parental contact and social opportunities for families

A range of activities were organised over the year providing opportunities for pupils/parents to meet up socially. A parent social group has organised events such as park meets and soft play. There was also a Christmas family celebration which received positive feedback. An end of year celebration will also be taking place with a 'fun fair' theme. Survey results show that parents are largely happy with the school provision.

Thank you for all of your hard work with the Healthy Schools programme this year which is continuing to develop the health and wellbeing of pupils. We congratulate everyone at Westhaven who has been involved in your Healthy Schools journey this year helping children to live happier, healthier lives.
